Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to pay and become a member?

It is not required but we do ask volunteers to pay membership (between S15 - S30 for the year) to help support and cover costs such as insurance, mountain fees, new equipment and more to ensure our program can continue safely on modern equipment for all children to learn and enjoy! If you can't pay or wish not to, simply answer 'Yes' when asking for a fee waiver in the Junior Program Portal. From there, you can bypass the membership fee. If you have participating children, you must get approval from your School's Family Support Liaison to waive any fees. If you pay a family membership, this covers you!

How do I complete a NH Criminal Background Check!

Scan the QR code on the bottom of page 1 or visit the Volunteer page at easternslopeskiclub.org to find information and links for both SAU background check processes. All ESSC volunteers must complete a background check. If you already have a current NH Criminal Background Check on file with the SAU you will be volunteering for, contact the SAU office to verify compliance.

Do I still use the online portal if I don't have kids in school?

Yes! Please scan the QR code and make an account. If you have a partner who will also be volunteering, add them as the 'Additional Parent/Guardian'. Once prompted to add children, simply leave the fields blank and cotinue to the next page. Under My Family Members, click on your name and fill out the appropriate Volunteer
